## Notes and conditions to membership application

**Full membership** includes

- 1 Entitlement to benefits provided by the Association:
  - Annual programme of events, including meetings at the Association apiary.
  - Voting rights at general meetings.
  - Use of Association extraction facilities and microscopes.
  - Mentor support for new beekeepers.
  - Access to locally raised strains of the native honeybee.
  - Discounts on beekeeping supplies from C Wynne Jones and products from Patchwork Paté.
  - Association Honey Show in (Currently held in October)
- 2 Membership of the Welsh Beekeepers' Association ([www.wbka.com](http://www.wbka.com)) which provides
  - Product and public liability cover.
  - Quarterly magazine.
  - Reduced rate for the Annual Convention.

**Associate membership** is normally appropriate for beekeepers' spouses, partners or children and full members of other Associations. Associate members do not have all the rights held by full members but are welcome to attend our meetings and courses. Associate Member are entitled to:

- (a) Vote at the AGM and at an SGM
- (b) Act as a proposer or seconder at the AGM and at an SGM
- (c) Be elected to serve as an Association Trustee.

**Junior Membership** is open to anyone under 18 years of age. If they keep bees they will pay the same as an Ordinary Member and be classified as Junior Ordinary Member. If they do not keep bees they will enjoy free membership and be classified as Junior Associate member. They will enjoy the same benefits except that Junior Members:

- (a) Can attend the AGM and an SGM but with no voting rights
- (b) Cannot act as a proposer or seconder at the AGM or SGM
- (c) Cannot serve as an Association Trustee

N.B. On their 18th birthday the word Junior will be removed from their Class of Membership and they will become either an Ordinary or Associate Member with the appropriate entitlements.

### Data protection

The Association will comply with the Data Protection Principles. Information will only be shared with the National Bee Unit, Food and Environment Research Agency (FERA), Bee Diseases Insurances Ltd (BDI), Welsh Beekeepers' Association (WBKA), officers of the Association and both C Wynne Jones and Patchwork Pate who provide member discounts.

### **Native Honey Bee Research Fund**

The Association is funding an important postgraduate bee research project at Bangor University, the purpose of which is to determine the validity of morphometric approaches to characterise the genetic integrity of the western honey bee (*Apis mellifera mellifera*) at a sub-regional scale.

The results of this study will have important implications for SCBKA's monitoring and breeding programme, which currently relies on wing morphometry to identify bees with the desired native characteristics.
